New CDC recommendations: everyone 6 months and older should get a flu shot every year. Lincoln County Health and Human Services Flu Program would like to kick off the 2010-11 Flu Season with the following clinic:

Pneumonia shots (\$45) will also be available for those who qualify.

Flu shots are \$30 for adults without insurance and \$15 for children aged 6 months to 18 years without insurance. (No child will be turned away because of inability to pay.)

Lincoln County Health and Human Services will bill most insurances. You **must** present your insurance card at the time of service. Normal plan benefits, deductibles and co-insurances will apply
