Public Service Announcement

Lincoln County Public Health, Lincoln Community Health Centers and the four county School Based Health Centers are partnering to offer the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) along with other important school required vaccines to all students in an effort to immunize students at the beginning of the school year.

One dose of Tdap is required by Oregon State Immunization Law to be given to all incoming 7th grade students. This requirement serves to increase protection against pertussis (also known as whooping cough). Pertussis can be fatal for infants.

Lincoln County will be holding immunization drop-in clinics to get students and families ready for the new school year. Tdap, as well as many others vaccinations, will be available at the following clinics:

Vaccines For Children is a State funded program that makes it possible to offer any school required vaccine for \$15 per vaccination to any student not covered by insurance. However, please remember if you have insurance to bring your insurance card so they can be billed. Youth age 14 and under must have parental consent to receive any vaccine; youth age 15 and older are legally able to sign for their own vaccinations. No one will be refused service for inability to pay.
